Conditions for Call

1. graduated from a seminary recognized by the KAPC denomination and is a member of the same denomination or is eligible to join, and has at least 5 years of pastoral experience as a senior pastor or associate pastor in the United States after ordination.
2. possess mature faith character and leadership skills based on a solid foundation of Reformed theology
3. has no problem communicating in English and has no disqualification for staying and ministering in the U.S.

Documents to be submitted

1. resume (including work history and family relationships)
2. personal statement (including a statement of faith, pastoral experience, growth background, and citation of books, theologians, and pastors that have influenced your vision.
3. proof of final graduation (degree)
4. certificate of ordination from the presbytery of your home denomination
5. a letter of recommendation from a seminary professor or reputable pastor (including the recommender's contact information, sent directly to the Call Committee by the recommender)
6. 2 sermon videos within 6 months (including online links and sermon manuscripts)
